Dear Graduands,

The Degree Distribution Programme of the Department of Electrical Engineering will be held on 17.07.2026 from 3:30 pm to 5:30 pm in the Student Activity Center (SAC). **Graduands are required to occupy their allotted seats in the Bowl area by 3:00 pm.**

Due to space constraints at the venue, the number of guests permitted for the Department Degree Distribution Programme will be limited. Kindly take note of the following points:

- All faculty members and graduands (PhD, MS, MTech, Web-based MTech, PG Diploma, Dual Degree, and BTech) will be seated in the Bowl area.
- Each graduand is permitted to bring up to three guests, who will be accommodated in the Gallery area. The event will be livestreamed on YouTube, and additional guests may watch it on their personal devices. Details of D3P and the live-stream link will be shared on the department website (<https://www.ee.iitm.ac.in/>).
- Guests are kindly requested to follow the instructions of the staff and seat themselves closely, without leaving gaps, to ensure optimal use of available space.
- Guests are requested not to block the view of others by standing up to take photographs. Professional photographs of the graduand receiving the degree, with the folder closed, will be taken and shared later.
- All graduands and guests are requested to keep their mobile phones in silent mode or switched off throughout the programme.
- Guests are encouraged to bring their own water bottles. Drinking water dispensers will be available at the venue for refilling.

As degrees will be distributed to a large number of graduands, it is essential to follow the protocol strictly.

- All attendees should rise when the Chief Guest enters the stage.
- Graduands should remain seated throughout the event except when they are required to walk up to the stage to receive their degree or prize.
- Protocol for walking to the stage:
 - The staff will guide you on how to approach and move across the stage.
 - When your name is called, walk to the designated spot next to the HoD, receive the folder, and exit from the other side of the stage.
 - Since time is limited, please do not open the folder on the stage.
 - A photograph of the graduand receiving the degree, with the folder closed, will be taken and shared later.
 - If there is a discrepancy in the certificate, you can approach the staff members after the event for resolution. Do not disturb the proceedings of the programme.
- Graduands should return to their designated seats after walking off the stage.
- Graduands should remain seated until the Chief Guest leaves the stage at the end of the event and the MC issues instructions to disperse.
